III. ORGANIZATION OF A FORMAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Points are available for the organization of a formal educational program of not less than four (4) hours total duration, sponsored either entirely or jointly* in cooperation with another society or school by the section. An announcement must be submitted (either electronically or by mail) to all section members. An announcement of the program and letter describing it (course topic, outline of program) must be submitted to Headquarters no less than 10 days IN ADVANCE of the program. (NOTE: Time for meals can not be counted in the hours total but a 10 minute break in a two hour session can be counted.)

* If the program is co-sponsored, it must meet the following criteria:

- a) All promotional literature and activities for the educational program must recognize the co-sponsorship role of the ASNT SECTION;
- b) The program must be offered to all members of the ASNT section; and the other organization.
- c) An attendance certificate recognizing the ASNT section's co-sponsorship role must be offered to all attendees.

POINTS AVAILABLE

For submissions received no less than 10 days IN ADVANCE of the educational program, each lecture or demonstration hour 100

For submissions received less than 10 days in advance but no more than 5 days after starting date of program, each lecture or demonstration hour, 90

For submissions received following 5 days after starting date of program but before June 15, 2008, each lecture or demonstration hour 70

NOTE: Points are granted on a maximum of 16 lecture or demonstration hours per submission.

2. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM ATTENDANCE

Points are available for the number of students registered* for program in 1 A above.

* To obtain points, student's name and full address must be provided.

POINTS AVAILABLE

For submissions no later than 15 days after program ending date, each student	10
For submissions between 16 and 30 days after program ending date, each student	9
For submissions following 30 days after program ending date but before June 15, 2008	7
 MAXIMUM POSSIBLE POINTS, Activity 2	 400

3. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM PROMOTION TO OTHER TECHNICAL SOCIETIES OR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTES

Points are available for promotions of program(s) in A above.

POINTS AVAILABLE

For submissions within 15 days after the promotional presentation, each presentation	100
For submissions between 16 and 30 days after the promotional presentation, each presentation	90
For submissions following 30 days after the promotional presentation but before June 15, 2008, each presentation	70
 MAXIMUM POSSIBLE POINTS, Activity 3	 500

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4. PROMOTIONAL PROGRAM PRESENTATION TO HIGH SCHOOL, JUNIOR COLLEGE, COLLEGES, ETC.

Points are available for promotion to any type of educational institution or program (e.g., Career Day) on the nondestructive testing field and/or The American Society for Nondestructive Testing and the opportunities that a career in this field or membership in the Society offer. If promotional literature is needed, please call Headquarters. Submittals should be accompanied with some form of validation (e.g. letter from principal).

POINTS AVAILABLE

For submissions within 15 days after the promotional presentation	500
For submissions between 16 and 30 days after the promotional presentation, each presentation	450
For submissions following 30 days after the promotional presentation but before June 15, 2008, each presentation	350
MAXIMUM POSSIBLE POINTS, Activity 4	500
TOTAL MAXIMUM POSSIBLE POINTS, CATEGORY III	3,000

- B. Report Due:
- Activity 1: no less than 10 days in advance of program;
 - Activity 2: 15 days after program ending date;
 - Activity 3: 15 days after promotional presentation;
 - Activity 4: 15 days after promotional presentation.
