

## **ASNT FELLOWSHIP AWARD**

### **1.0 Purpose**

To fund research activity in NDT at the post-graduate level (M.S. or Ph.D.)

### **2.0 Eligibility**

ABET accredited academic institutions with graduate educational research programs.

### **3.0 Administration**

By the ASNT University Programs Committee of the Research Council.

### **4.0 University Selection**

The University Programs Committee will recommend the participating university based on:

- A proposal from the university outlining what the program or graduate study activity will consist of and how they will manage the fellowship. It must be received before October 15 each year.
- The amount and qualification of faculty support.
- NDT equipment available on campus for use in the program.
- Through ASNT HQ staff, committee will contact possible participants and solicit proposals.
- Final selection of the participating university will be after a review of the submitted proposals has been completed by the University Programs Committee

### **5.0 Notification**

The university(s) selected for the award shall be notified by the Chairman of the Board of Directors (Awards Committee Chairman) of the Society after Board review and approval. Each university submitting a proposal shall receive a letter of thanks for their interest and support of the program. Included in this letter shall be a list of the schools receiving the award(s).

### **6.0 Completion Requirements**

- A written report on the completed study or activity must be submitted to the University Program Committee no later than 24 months after program initiation as outlined in the proposal.
- The report must be in a format suitable for publication in *Materials Evaluation*.

## **POLICY J-5.2.1B**

- The fellowship student must present the findings at a national conference. ASNT will provide an airline ticket, hotel room for the conference and waive conference fees. (Reference motion Board 3-9-86.)

### **7.0 Funding**

Fellowship funding will be \$15,000 per award up to a maximum of three awards per year. Funds will be made available for the next year Fall school term, e.g. submission October 15, 1990, funds available Fall 1991.
